Reminder about the changes to After School Care Costs and School lunches after Easter

After Easter 'After school care' costs rise to £4 an hour. We will also charge for people who are repeatedly late for any club. If we only have one child booked into 'After school care' to 5.15pm in an evening we may discuss this with you to see if it can be moved to a different evening, and so we are not running at a deficit for that evening. Vertas is raising a school dinner cost to £2.80 a meal. Breakfast club will remain subsidised and still only cost £2 for a session.
