PE, Forest school and Beach school changes for this next half term

PE days may have changed for your child's class, please check class dojo for these changes.
Forest school will be for Willow class (Reception and Wednesday morning Nursery children) on Wednesday mornings. Please can the children wear PE kit for Wednesdays (or something similar for Nursery children) and have a spare pair of shoes or Wellies, so they have different footwear for inside and outside for Forest school. They will all need to have tracksuit bottoms or leggings on (tracksuit bottoms prevent more stings and scratches). They will also need a warm coat which is also waterproof, thank you.
Oak class (yrs 3 and 4) will be going to **Beach School** on Wednesday afternoons, they will need to be in track suit bottoms or leggings (tracksuit bottoms protect them more when climbing and it is cold) and again they will need two pairs of footwear, one for when at school and another for when they are at Beach School, they will also need a warm and waterproof coat, thank you.
